It's been an absolute joy to see the many strides Richard has made since 2008, when he first came in to see me. He'd experienced a lot of trauma in his life. Raised by a single mom who struggled with addiction, he lived on and off the streets in his youth. After overcoming his own battles with substance abuse, he worked hard to get healthy, stay healthy, and give his own daughter opportunities that he never had growing up.



Richard has grappled with asthma and a host of chronic health issues his whole life. It causes him a great deal of physical and emotional pain. Sometimes, bouts of depression make it hard for him to get the care he needs. So you can imagine how happy it makes me to see him after it's been a while, and to see the quiet pride in his eyes when he tells me things like, "Hey, I'm riding my bike to work now, and I've lost a little weight. I feel better."

For most of his life, Richard didn't have access to dental care. As a result, several of his teeth have rotted and fallen out. But since we opened our new dental clinic, he's come in regularly for cleanings and to get cavities filled. It's given him a brighter smile that beams confidence — and hope for more and more many strides toward a healthier future.
